Experience the power of art in the heart of Carmel! The 27th Annual Carmel International Arts Festival will be held on **September 27 & 28, 2025**, in Carmel, Indiana. Artists from around the world gather in the heart of Old Town Carmel's Arts & Design District at the intersection of Main Street and Range Line Road. The Carmel International Arts Festival is a juried exhibition with prizes totaling \$7,000. Annually, **25,000+ festival-goers** enjoy an admission-free opportunity to view and purchase art, mingle with artists, tour local galleries, dine at fine restaurants, and enjoy the Festival's entertainment on multiple stages.

The nine media categories are as follows: **2D, 3D, Ceramics, Fiber, Glass, Jewelry, Painting, Photography, and Wood**. Throughout the two days, CIAF awards over \$14,000 in scholarships through a jury selection for local high school students, directly supporting the next generation of artists and creatives in our community.

The Mission of the Carmel International Arts Festival is to educate the public about art and artists from around the world; to provide scholarships to art students to further their education; and to hold art festivals to promote and educate the public about art, all within the meaning of our 501(c)(3).
